NOTICE: This Addendum No.1, issued in accordance with the Contract Documents, is incorporated into the Contract Documents and supersedes and updates all conflicting information and is hereby amended in certain particulars as follows:

CHANGES TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:

- 1. Technical Specifications Section 01060, add this note under 1.01.A.3
 - a. Contractor is to submit request to work within MDOT right-of-way to the Owner 14 days before work is to begin in MDOT right-of-way.
- 2. In all instances, change quantity of 8" pipe sewer line cleaning from 16,300 ft to 16,800 ft.
- 3. Replace Section 410, Bid Form, in its entirety with the attached, revised Bid Form. The revised Section 410 revises the estimated quantity of 8" sewer pipe and adds line item 12: Lead Intrusion Cleaning
- 4. Section 01025, Add the following immediately following paragraph 1.04E:
 - F. Item 12 Tap Cutting

1. Payment includes furnishing and operating all equipment and labor to document and cut service taps extending into the flow channel of the sewer. Only those intrusions significant enough to prevent passage of camera or cleaning equipment, or that have evidence of creating a blockage of debris in the flow line will be eligible for payment.

2. Unit of Measure: Payment will be made on a per each basis for each extruding tap cut, as documented by before and after photographs, and approved by the Engineer.

CHANGES TO THE PLANS:

1. Replace Appendix A in its entirety with the updated drawings that identify flow direction and additional sewer sections to be cleaned.

GENERAL CONTRACTOR QUESTION AND CLARIFICATIONS

- 1. The list of pre-bid meeting attendees is attached to this addendum. In accordance with the Bid Advertisement and Article 6 of the Instructions to Bidders, the prospective bidders in attendance are the only bidders eligible to submit a bid as a prime contractor.
- In the Standard General Conditions Article 7.02.B states work "shall be performed during regular working hours, Monday through Friday". Regular working hours are from 7:00am to 7:00pm.
- 3. Section 02762 Part 3.01.B, the Contractor will be allowed to dispose of collected liquids, generated during cleaning of the sewer system, at either a designated manhole or the wastewater treatment plant as approved by the Owner and Engineer. These liquids must be free of debris that could cause harm either the collection or treatment system. All solids must be gathered for disposal by the contractor.
- 4. Per Section 02762 Part 3.01.C.4, the Owner has specified that Contractor may obtain water from township fire hydrants at the fee rate of \$1.50/1000 gallons used. Only the fire department or IAI may operate the hydrants valves; the Contractor may operate a valve installed downstream of the backflow preventer. The Contractor shall supply, and Engineer shall approve, a double check backflow preventer and meter with shutoff valve.
- 5. Based on available construction drawings, all pipe materials appear to be PVC. Neither the pipe material specifications nor construction methods are known.
- 6. Pipes and manholes exist in either the road right-of-way or easements that provide for their access. Access to structures within private easements and MDOT ROW requires notification 14 days prior to access.
