Water Supply Well No. 3

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Haring Charter Township located at 515 Bell Ave, Cadillac, MI, 49601, until Friday, November 7, 2025 at 12 PM local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

- A. Water Supply Well: 800 gpm at 240 TDH submersible pump, drop pipe, downwire, pitless adapter, security cover, connection to water system, startup, testing, and abandonment of one existing 5" observation well.**

Bids are requested for the following Contract: Water Supply Well No. 3 Pumping Equipment

Funding

Compliance with the Davis Bacon Act and adherence to the current U.S. Department of Labor Wage Decision requires that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project.

This agreement is for services related to a project that is subject to the Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA) requirements under Title IX of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("IIJA"), Pub. L. 117-58. Absent an approved waiver, all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in this project must be produced in the United States, as further outlined by the Office of Management and Budget's Memorandum M-22-11, Initial Implementation Guidance on Application of Buy America Preference in Federal Financial Assistance Programs for Infrastructure, April 18, 2022.
