

# INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Shelby Township will receive Bids for the installation of a public water system, booster station, master meter and vault, and associated appurtenances, Shelby Township Water System until 2 PM., Daylight Saving Time on the 30th day of August 2023 at 204 N. Michigan Avenue, Shelby, MI 49455 at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids are invited upon the several items and quantities of work as follows:

A prepackaged booster station located on the east side of Oceana Drive and 1,300 feet north of Harrison St. The booster station will be equipped with two 25 Hp pumps each rated for 365 gpm @ 183 TDH and one 100 Hp pump rated for 1,365 gpm @ 183 TDH. Each pump will be equipped with a variable frequency drive to maintain a set discharge pressure and minimum suction pressure of 20 psi. Station includes backup power and all other equipment as required for proper operation.

A master meter and vault located 1,300 feet north of Harrison St. connected downstream of the booster station.

8,708 feet 10-inch water main in Oceana Dr from connection to booster station north to Baseline Rd.

6,433 feet 8-inch water main in Baseline Rd from Oceana Dr. to housing located at the northeast corner of Baseline Rd. and N 88th Avenue. Service connections to customers.

Site restoration to disturbed areas.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above. Bidding Documents are available on compact disc (as portable document format (PDF) files) for a non-refundable charge at \$no cost, which includes standard shipping. Alternatively, printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office either via in-person pick-up or via mail, upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment for the Bidding Documents. The non-refundable cost of printed Bidding Documents is \$200 [two hundred] per set, payable to "Gosling Czubak Engineering Sciences", which includes standard shipping plus an additional shipping charge of \$36 (thirty-six) for overnight express service if requested. Upon Issuing Office's receipt

of payment, printed Bidding Documents will be sent via the prospective Bidder's delivery method of choice; the shipping charge will depend on the shipping method chosen. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of Shelby Township, negotiable U.S. Government bonds (at par value) or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

A mandatory pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on Tuesday, August 15, 2023 at 2 PM at Shelby Township at 204 N. Michigan Avenue, Shelby, MI 49455. Bids will not be accepted from Bidders that do not attend the mandatory pre-bid conference.

Shelby Township reserves the right to reject any or all Bids or to waive any informality in the bidding.

Bids may be held by Shelby Township for a period not to exceed 30 days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.

A firm fixed-price contract award will be made in writing to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
